Sessions

- The conference will have a series of sessions based on the themes (<http://www.iris.no/nets2014/themes>) of the conference.
- Please make us aware which session you would like to submit to by writing it on the top of abstract submission.

Oral and Poster Presentations

- Oral presentations cannot be requested. These are assigned by the session conveners and Program Committee based on the total number of submissions received.
- Poster presentations may be requested. These requests will be honored by the conveners and Program Committee.
- Submission of an abstract carries with it the obligation to give a presentation in the designated manner assigned.
- To make either an oral or a poster presentation, the presenter must be listed on an abstract at the time of electronic publication. An individual should not present someone else's paper, if their name is not listed as an author on the abstract.

Abstract Content

- Abstracts must focus on scientific results or their application. The Program Committee may decline to consider abstracts with other focus.
- Following the abstract deadline, submitted papers may be placed in a different, more appropriate session than the one to which it was submitted. Final decisions regarding placement of individual papers and sessions rests with the Program Committee.
- The abstract title is limited to 300 characters and the extended abstract text is limited to 5000 characters including spaces. Ordinary abstracts are also acceptable, with a 3000 character maximum.
- Please use Times New Roman, 12pt, Single space, Justified, for your abstract.
- Please save your text as a pdf-file (preferred) or Word-file and append it to an email to nets2014@iris.no.

Authors

- The First Author will receive all communications regarding their abstract.
- First Authors can have a maximum of one (1) contributed and one (1) invited abstract.

Affiliation

- Please note the affiliation of each of the authors, using a suffix next to their name, and listing the affiliations below the author names. The first author should indicate their email address (mandatory) and telephone number (voluntary).

Presentations

- Poster-boards will be Portrait orientation, maximum one (1) meter wide for each poster. The boards are 1.05 meter tall, but the poster can hang below the board if you want to them to.
- Talks (except Keynotes) are 12 + 3 minutes (presentation + questions). Please deliver your talk on a memory-stick in due time before your session starts.
